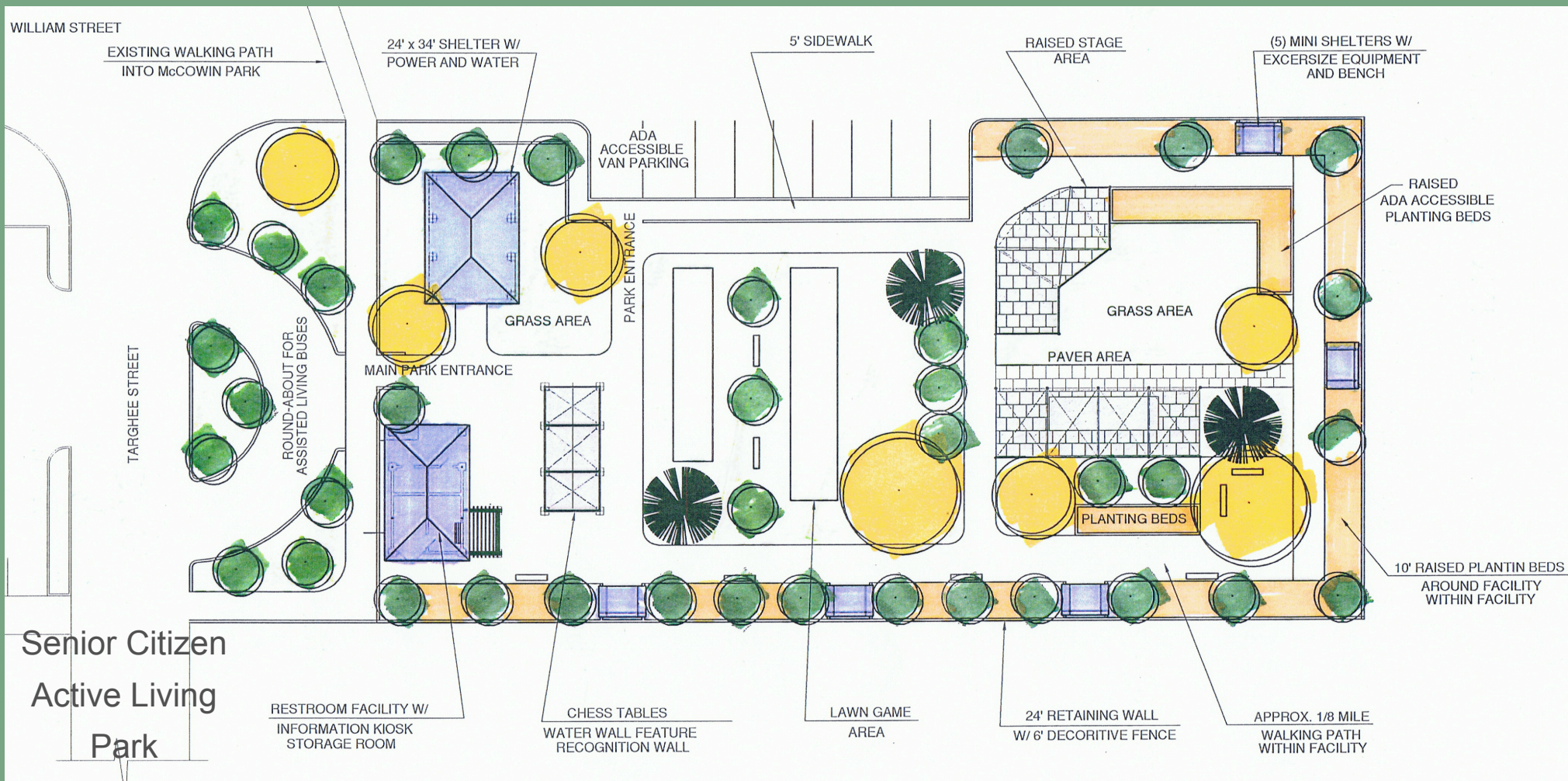

- ★ Lawn area for Bocce or Horseshoes or other games
- ★ Community gardens and raised planting beds
- ★ Outdoor physical therapeutic fitness equipment
